A Night at the Museum for Adults

Information Sheet

This sheet provides information on overnight stays for children at the NHM Vienna. Please read it carefully in order to best prepare yourself.

Please note that the event itself is held in German.

Tickets / dates

You can purchase tickets through the [ticket shop](#). New dates are announced via the general newsletter, which you can sign up for [here](#). Please have your tickets ready at the entrance.

Cancellation

Cancellation is not possible. If you are unable to participate, please contact ticketing@nhm.at.

Can I bring children along?

No. "A Night at the Museum" is for adults 18 and over. There is a corresponding event for children between 7 and 11 years old. You can find more information [here](#).

When do I have to be at the museum?

The event starts at 7 p.m. Please come to the main entrance on time. After you have arrived, you can set yourself up in the dinosaur hall where you will sleep later.

What happens when I arrive late?

If you are arriving late, please contact the porter at the side entrance, Burgring 7 (tel. +43 1 52177-205).

What do I need to bring?

You will need to bring a sleeping bag, a cushion (optional), toiletries, comfortable clothing for the night, as well as a torchlight. There are no showers available. The museum provides camping beds. The NHM Vienna does not assume liability for any items lost.

Can I choose where to sleep?

The beds will be set up in the dinosaur hall. The other halls will be closed after the torchlight tour.

Where can I change for the night?

A cloakroom with cubicles is available, which you can use to change. Bathrooms are located right next to the dinosaur hall.

Should I bring food? Is alcohol permitted?

A dinner and breakfast buffet are included in the price (excluding beverages), as well as a welcome drink and a drink on the roof top of the museum. It is therefore not necessary to bring additional food and drink with you. It is not allowed to bring alcoholic beverages. Eating and drinking are not permitted in the exhibition halls.

Is smoking permitted?

Smoking, as well as any open fire (candles etc.) are not permitted in the museum.

What is the exact program?

When can I leave the museum?

The museum is closed between 6 p.m. and 9 a.m. During this time, it is not possible to leave the building through the main entrance. If necessary, you can leave the museum through the side entrance, which is staffed around the clock. Our staff will assist you in case of need.
